### Local writer has signed two book deals

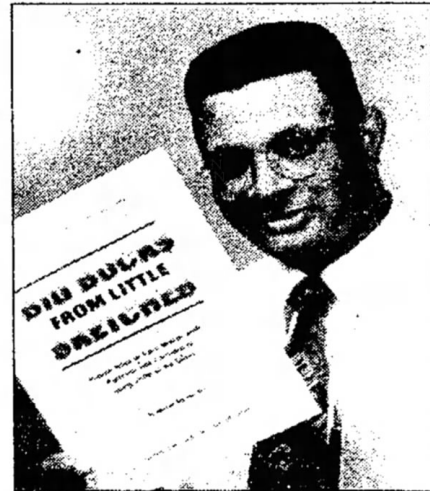
When students across the world sign up to study art with International Correspondence Schools (Scranton), they will use a book written by local author Roscoe Barnes III.

The book is titled, "Big Bucks From Little Sketches: Proven Ways to Earn Money with Portraits and Caricatures Using Little or No Talent." The book was purchased by ICS after Barnes had first published it himself.

The second deal he recently signed was for a book about World War II. Due out on Saturday, the book is titled "Off to War: Franklin Countians in World War II." It will be published by White Mane Publishing, Shippensburg.

The book chronicles the experiences of 13 World War II veterans. Amid drama, pain and sometimes humor, the veterans recall their experiences in graphic details.

Pennsylvania Sen. Terry Punt wrote the preface for the book
